FUNDING REQUESTS FOR FY2017-2018: The Council reviewed the funding requests for the FY2017-2018. Motion approving the 28E Agreements and funding requests totaling \$54,626 for FY2017-2018 as follows: SHIELD - \$11,394, Water Quality Commission - \$14,800, NWIPDC - \$563, Dickinson Co. EMA - \$3,826, RIDES - \$3,375, Dickinson County Trails Board - \$4,218, UDMO - \$1,000, CAASA - \$1,500, EMS - \$1,000, Compass Pointe - \$500, Chamber of Commerce – Fireworks - \$1,050, Discovery House - \$1,000, Lakes Art Center - \$1,400, Trees Forever - \$1,000, Iowa Great Lakes Corridor - \$3,500, Blue Water Festival - \$2,500, Meals on Wheels - \$1,500, and Lakes Area Dog Park - \$500.
