Motion approving Consent Agenda consisting of Minutes, Claims, Clerk's & Treasurer's reports. Adams/Watters. Ayes: Five. Nays: None. Absent: None.

Consensus of the Council is to table the liquor license for Ciao Boji until the parking requirements are met.

ANIMAL CONTROL: John French and Diane Daws requested that the Council implement a Leash Ordinance. Council and attendees discussed the subject at length. Motion to set a public hearing for August 12, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. to discuss a possible change to the current ordinance, Chapter 55 Animal Protection and Control. Richter/Adams. Ayes: Five. Nays: None. NO PARKING ZONES: Citing safety concerns Police Chief Krueger requested that the west curve between Helms Drive and Dam Road be designated a no parking zone. Fire Chief Yungbluth agreed that the current parking would be hazardous if a rescue vehicle needed access. Christensen stated that the City has already reduced parking in that area and should try to retain as much parking as possible. Council agreed that the area can be dangerous with cars parked on the curve and would like to see some restrictions.
