2023 STONE BENCH/STEPS RESTORATION LAKE BANK STABILIZATION LAKEVIEW BOULEVARD PROJECT: Rose presented the Council with a change order for the stone benches/steps along Pillsbury Point. Upon washing the benches, it was discovered that there is a floor to them thereby increasing the labor cost associated with the restoration.
